Despite of father's income and her mother's hardship on field they are facing many difficulties in meeting children school fees and it's need.

As such Tibetan Children Village has accepted to pay stipend for this child's subsistence through TCV Outreach Program. This program takes care and educates most vulnerable and needy children.

Once the case is accepted the family will receive a monthly stipend allowance to help meet the family's need like children's food, clothing, education and health etc.
