Life History of the child and reasons for sponsorship:

About the Village: The word Shachukul is said to have derived from Shar-Khul(Shar for easy and Khul for corner) which mean a corner facing to the East. Due to having slope terrain of the mountain the glacial melt water flows from the west toward the east, which makes people from other places, feel so different to be in Shachukul. The temperature has never gone up more than +25 degree throughout the year. In summer it is beautiful though it is icy cold in winter, temperature dips down to minus 35. People of this village do farming and labor work.

Editso Nurkit and her parents live at a remote place call Lugkung in Shachukul village and they do farming on a small plot of land. Whatever comes from the farm is use by them self. Being in the cold region of ladakh they can only do farming for the summer season and in winter her father try to get labor works at the nearby army camps. Whatever her father earns is spend on the daily needs of the family and they also have to store rations for the winter season as ladakh remain out of from rest of the world. Her mother helps her father in farming and also does household works. She also has to look after old grandparents and the children. In all this sending their children to a good school was out of question for them, They does send her to a small local school which was not so regular, However with the grace of His Holiness The Dalai Lama every year we take five children from their village & nearby their village and this time Nurkit got lucky that she got enroll in our village and she will starting going to kindergarten stage III from March 2020. She is little over age as compare to other kids in the same call, but I am sure she will be a responsible girl.

Personally, Nurkit has a fair complexion with burn cheeks due to harsh climate in their village and she has a nice black hair with good health. She said English is her best subject and Pink is her best color. She looks intelligent and speaks very well. She also love playing with her little sister and they do dance and play together. She said she is very excited to go to school and she is going to stay at our family boarding home no 20. For now she is in need of your kind support towards her studies up till class XII. We shall keep you update about her progress in school twice a year and her fresh picture and Christmas greetings every year.
